Dear Jess,

I am writing on behalf of a constituent who provided evidence to the Independent Inquiry into Child Sexual Abuse. She visited my constituency surgery on Friday 10th January 2025, following recent news coverage that prompted her to share her perspective as a survivor.

My constituent gave evidence to IICSA in the hope that her contribution would help prevent others from suffering the same trauma. However, she was shocked to learn last week that none of Professor Jay's recommendations have yet been fully implemented. She expressed feelings of deep frustration that politicians of all stripes have collectively failed to ensure the Jay report's findings are acted upon, and have thereby failed in their duty to survivors like her. She was particularly frustrated that the debate in recent days has focused on whether a new inquiry is needed, rather than on implementing the recommendations made by IICSA.

My constituent is calling for the government to take immediate action and deliver fully on all the recommendations made by IICSA, without further delay.

Please could you provide me, and my constituent, with an update on the government's plans to implement these recommendations, and the expected time frame for their delivery.

Thank you for your attention to this important issue. I look forward to your response.
